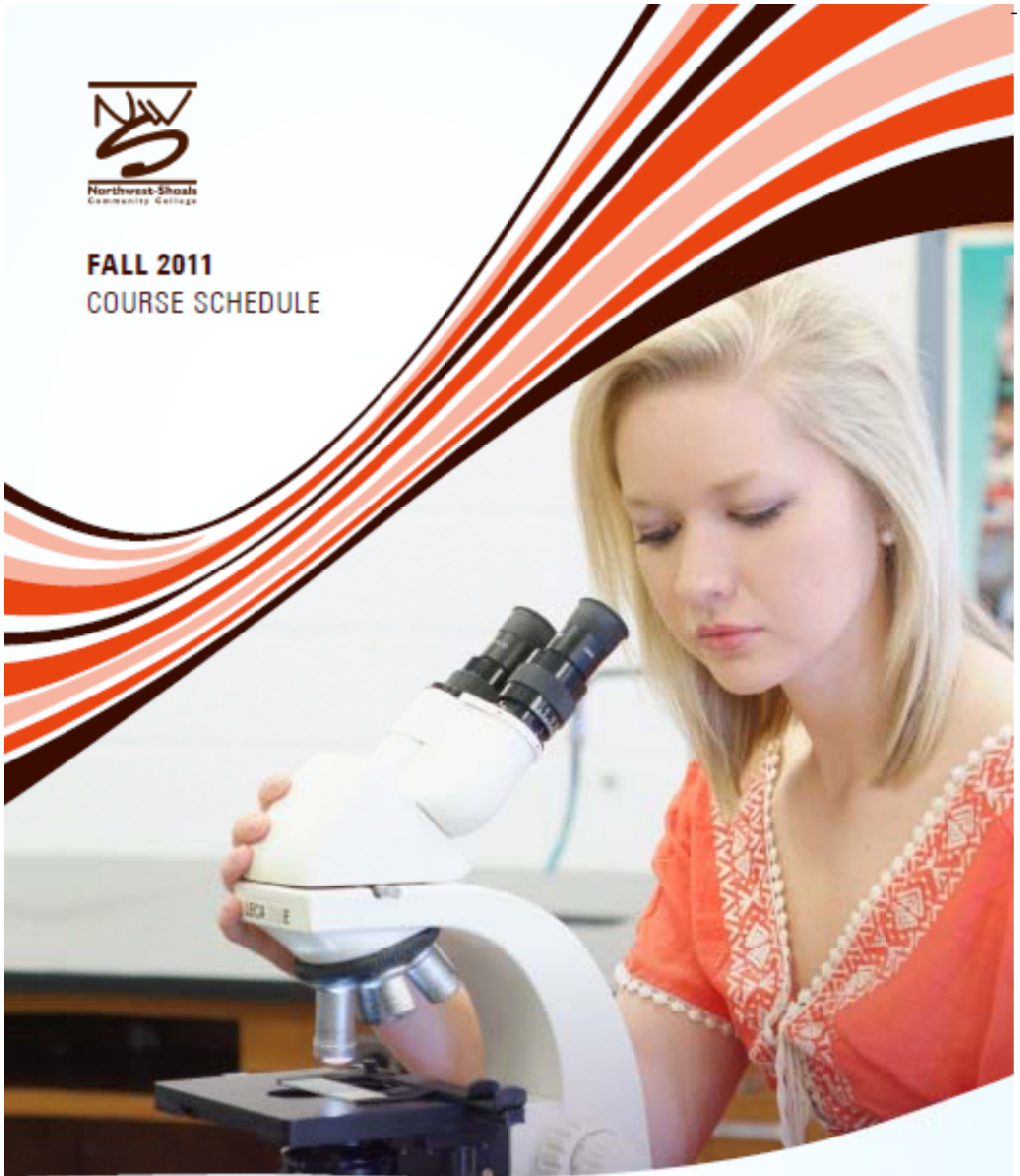

### SPECIAL INFORMATION

To be able to register, all currently enrolled students must have a Photo I.D. Card.

After currently enrolled students have met with their advisors and obtained clearance to register, students have the following registration options:

1. Web-Based registration.
2. Faculty members may enter the student's registration in their offices.
3. Admissions Office available for registration problems.

### WEB REGISTRATION

July 16-August 16

Currently enrolled students can register on the web beginning at 7:30 a.m., July 16, 2011 through August 16, 2011. In order to use the web registration option each student will need his/her student number and personal identification number (PIN). All currently enrolled students **MUST** see their assigned advisors for schedule approval and clearance to register. Students should make sure they have the correct call numbers for all classes for which they wish to register. In the event some classes are full, alternate call numbers should already be selected and approved by the advisor. Tuition and fees can be paid by credit card using web registration. All student information is encrypted to ensure the privacy and confidentiality of personal information.

### DUAL ENROLLMENT/DUAL CREDIT REGISTRATION

July 25-29

High school students who enroll for the fall semester for dual enrollment/dual credit must submit the following items to the Admissions Office:

1. Completed application for admission and student I.D. policy form.
2. Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit Agreement Form completed and signed by superintendent and high school principal.
3. High school transcript.
4. ACT/COMPASS scores.

### TRANSIENT STUDENT REGISTRATION

July 25-29

Transient students attending Northwest-Shoals Community College for the first time may take advantage of early registration for the fall semester. A completed application for admission and an approved transient letter must be submitted to the Admissions Office by July 14, 2011, to register early.

Students who have not submitted a completed application for admission and an approved transient letter by July 14, 2011 will register at Open Registration, August 16, 2011.

# Registration Procedures

## Registration is August 16, 2011

Students registering on the Phil Campbell Campus should report to **Building 301-Administration Building**. Students registering on the Shoals Campus should report to **Building 127 - Workforce Development**.

The following steps are to be followed by First-time Freshmen, Transfers, Transient, Dual Enrollment, and Readmitting Students.

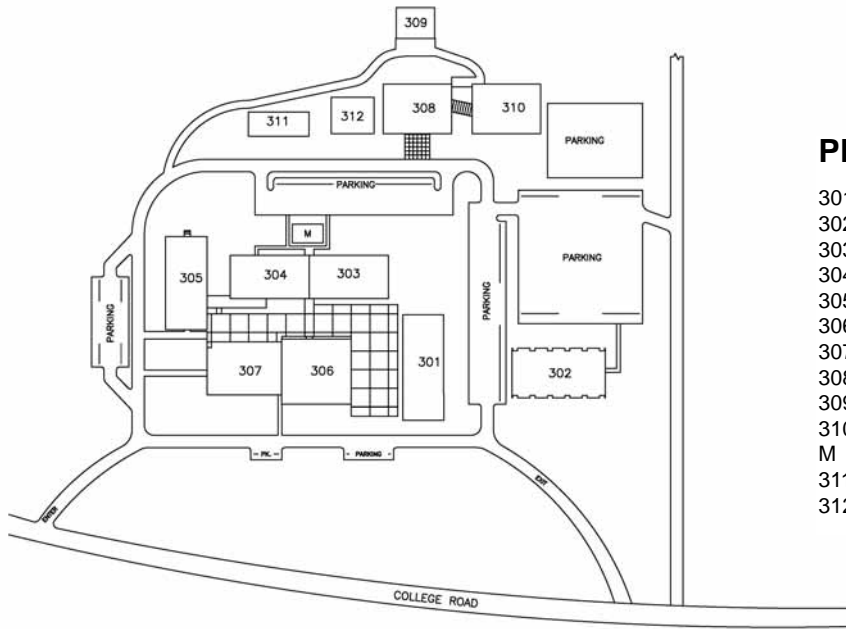
**August 16 8:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. & 4:30 p.m.-7:00 p.m.**

- Step 1. Report to **Check-In Station** of the appropriate campus.
- Step 2. If an application for admission or readmission has not been completed, go to the **Walk-In Work Area** to complete application. (A readmission application must be completed, if the student is not enrolled for the current semester.) If the application for admission has already been submitted to the Admissions Office, go to **Photo I.D. Station**.
- Step 3. **Photo I.D. Station:** Have picture taken for Photo I.D. and register vehicle for parking decal. Tag number is required to obtain parking decal.
- Step 4. **Testing:** Take COMPASS test, if appropriate. Students who have not successfully completed college-level English and/or math must take the COMPASS test, unless they made 20 or above on the math and/or English portion of the ACT College Entrance Exam. Then go to the **Advising Transcript Station** to obtain COMPASS scores and/or transfer credit and meet with assigned advisor to schedule appropriate classes.
- Step 5. Take completed registration form to the **Data Entry/Invoice Station** for processing. If any classes the student is registering for are full, go to the **Scheduling/Help Area** for assistance. Return to the **Data Entry/Invoice Station** to complete this step and receive printed invoice.
- Step 6. All students **must** go to the **Financial Aid Station** for financial assistance review.
- Step 7. Take invoice to the **Cashier Office** for payment of tuition and fees. All students whether paying tuition by cash, charging to a scholarship or financial aid program, must go to the **Cashier Office**. Schedules of students not completing this step will be cancelled. Pay tuition and fees by **7:00 p.m., August 16** to avoid cancellation of class schedule. Photo I.D. cards will be validated at the time tuition is paid.

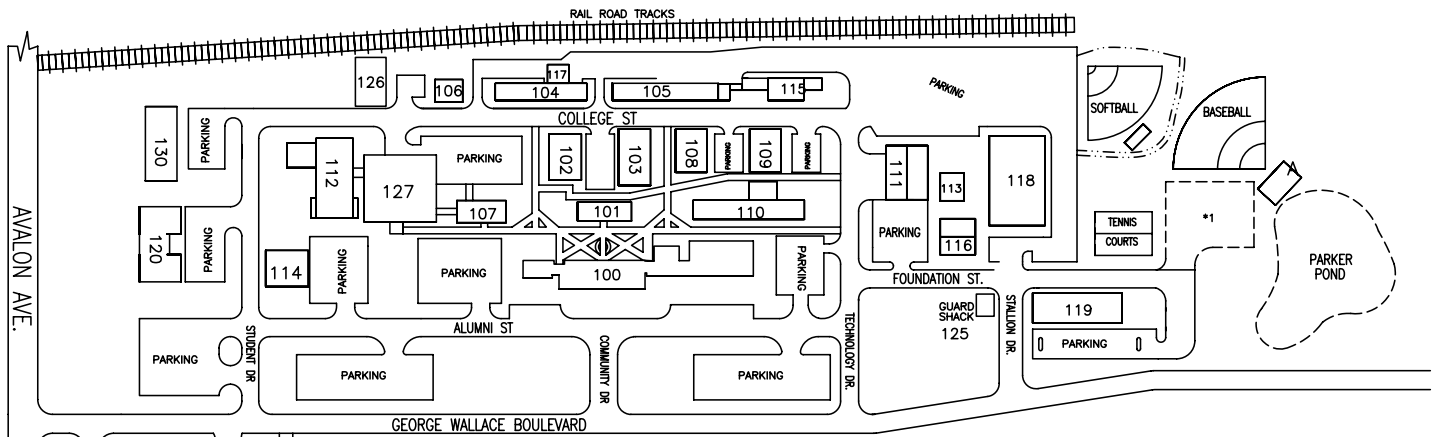

- Apply for Federal Aid now for Fall 2011.
- Students need to submit their application for Federal Aid online at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) for the 2011-12 year.
- A pin number is required when submitting your application. If you do not have one, please apply at [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov)
- Financial Aid staff are available to help if needed.
- The school code is 005697 for both campuses.
- Follow up in the Financial Aid office approximately one (1) week after completing the FAFSA online. Student will need to bring 2010 taxes and W2's.

## FINANCIAL AID OFFICE

To obtain information regarding financial help for your expenses at NW-SCC, visit our Financial Aid Offices or pick up an Application for Federal Student Aid.

Remember to apply for Federal Aid at least four weeks before classes begin. Personnel are available to help you complete the forms. Students may apply on-line using their Federal PIN at website [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov). **The FAFSA school code for both campuses is 005697.** Additional aid is available through scholarships and outside sponsors for those who qualify.

**Notice to Students:** New/Transfer Students who have sent their application to Federal Student Aid and have not received a response within 3-4 weeks, please contact our offices. Students who have received their Federal Student Aid Report, please bring the 2010 income information.

**Deadline:** Students must have Federal Pell Grants and Federal Direct Student Loans approved by the Financial Aid Office prior to the August 16, 2011, Open Registration Day if charges are to be made. Students without prior approval should make plans to pay (cash, check, credit card) on the August 16, 2011, Open Registration Day. Reimbursements will be made later when students are officially approved for aid.

Student Loans for one (1) semester will be disbursed in two (2) payments. The second disbursement will be made at the 50% point (October 12, 2011) of the semester.

Financial Aid Offices are located on both the Shoals and Phil Campbell Campuses. In Muscle Shoals, the office is located on George Wallace Boulevard in Building 100. In Phil Campbell, the office is located in the Administration Building.

**Ability to Benefit:** Students who do not have a GED or high school diploma are permitted to use Federal Student Aid in a limited number of occupational programs. Students must pass all three parts of the COMPASS test at the same time before receiving aid. Please contact Adult Education at 256-331-5438.

**Deadline for charges: Students on federal financial aid (Pell & Student Loan) must make all charges in the Cashier's Office or Bookstore by August 26, 2011. All other financial aid charges end September 14, 2011.**

## FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID

Students on Federal Student Aid (Pell Grant & Loan) who totally withdraw from classes before the 60% point (October 24, 2011) in the semester may be required to repay a portion of their funds to the U.S. Department of Education, lender, or NW-SCC.

## REFUND POLICY

A copy of the Refund Policy Number 803.02 issued Sept. 26, 1996, by the Department of Postsecondary Education, with guidelines for the policy, can be obtained from an employee in the NW-SCC Business or Admissions Office. For additional information concerning refunds from the College refer to pages 18-19 in the 2010-2011 College Catalog.

A sample of how the tuition refunds are calculated can be obtained by contacting an employee in the NW-SCC Cashier's Office.

### Refund for Complete Withdrawal

A student who officially or unofficially withdraws from all classes before the first day of class will be refunded the total tuition and other institutional charges.

A student who officially or unofficially withdraws completely on or after the first day of class but prior to the end of the third week of class will be refunded according to the official withdrawal date, as follows:

Deadlines	Percent
1. Prior to <b>August 18</b>	100%
2. Withdrawal first week: <b>August 18-24</b>	75%*
3. Withdrawal second week: <b>August 25-31</b>	50%*
4. Withdrawal third week: <b>September 1-7</b>	25%*

**\*Administrative Fee** - An administrative fee not to exceed five (5) percent of tuition and other institutional charges or \$100, whichever is smaller, shall be assessed in addition to the reduced percentage, for each withdrawal within the period beginning the first day of class and ending at the end of the third week of class.

**Refund for Partial Withdrawal** - Students who do not completely withdraw from the College but drop a class during the regular drop/add period will be refunded the difference in tuition paid and the tuition rate applicable to the reduced number of hours, including fees appropriate to the classes dropped. There is no refund due to a student who partially withdraws after the official drop/add period.

## REFUNDS TO STUDENTS

NW-SCC strives to improve the service provided to our students and prospective students. Offering a choice about how to receive financial disbursements from the institution is one recent improvement. In 2006, we partnered with Higher One, a financial services company specializing in disbursement methods. The U.S. Department of Education also recognizes the need for improving disbursement methods and made changes to its policy, 34 CFR 668.164, allowing institutions to require banking information from all students. Beginning in July 2008, Northwest-Shoals will ask students to provide this banking information. The information will be solely used for refund disbursement and remain completely confidential as required by FERPA. All refunds from Northwest-Shoals will now become electronic after July 2008. Students without a bank account will have the option of opening an account to use for all disbursements from the college.

### Cancellation of Classes:

Every effort is made to insure that courses and programs described in the College Catalog are offered to students in an appropriate and reasonable sequence. Students should be aware, however, that admission to the College or registration for a given semester does not guarantee the availability of a specific course. Course availability is determined by student demand and instructor availability. Northwest-Shoals Community College reserves the right to cancel or modify any class scheduled.

## STUDENT INSURANCE BENEFITS

### ELIGIBILITY

All eligible students of Northwest-Shoals Community College are covered for the activities while under the care and direction of the school with the exception of Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit.

### POLICY EFFECTIVE DATE

The Policy is effective from semester to semester.

### MEDICAL EXPENSE BENEFITS

If the Insured Student incurs eligible expenses as the result of a covered injury, directly and independently of all other causes, the Company will pay the charges incurred for such expense within 52 weeks, beginning on the date of accident. Payment will be made for eligible expenses not to exceed \$10,000. The first such expense must be incurred within 60 days after the date of the accident. "Eligible Expense" means charges for the following necessary treatment and service, not to exceed the usual and customary charges in the area where provided, including:

- 1) Medical and surgical care by a physician;
- 2) Radiology (X-rays);
- 3) Prescription drugs and medicines;
- 4) Dental treatment of sound natural teeth;
- 5) Hospital care and service in semi-private accommodations, or as an outpatient;
- 6) Ambulance service from the scene of the accident to the nearest hospital;
- 7) Orthopedic appliances necessary to promote healing.

### CLAIM PROCEDURE

In the event of an accident, the student should:

- 1) Report immediately to the nearest doctor or hospital.
- 2) A completed claim form is required for each accident in order to process the claim. Secure a claim form from the cashier's office or online at [www.studentplanscenter.com](http://www.studentplanscenter.com). Complete and sign the claim form, attach all medical and hospital bills and mail to the Plan Underwriter below.
