GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION/REQUIREMENTS

- A Northwest-Shoals Community College Application for Admission **MUST** be on file for all applicants in order to qualify.
- High school applicants are **REQUIRED** to attach a copy of their high school transcripts, in addition to the official transcript sent with the Application for Admission. High school transcripts must reflect grades earned from 9th grade through first semester of 12th grade.
- Copies of transcripts from other institutions attended are required, if applicable. A copy of college transcript(s) must be attached to the application, including grades earned through end of fall term preceding the March 1st priority deadline (later if meeting secondary deadline application date).
- Information on specific scholarships can be found at the offices listed below or on Northwest-Shoals Community College's Financial Aid website at www.nwscc.edu
- Some scholarships **REQUIRE** submission of a portfolio or a live audition/interview from the students (i.e... Music, Ambassadors, College Bowl, Art)
- Students on scholarship are **REQUIRED** to maintain a specific grade point average and enroll for and complete at least twelve (12) hours per semester.
