# Dual Enrollment/ Dual Credit Program



The Dual Enrollment for Dual Credit Program (DE/DC) at NW-SCC allows eligible students to earn both high school and college credit. College courses count toward high school graduation credits and the courses remain a part of the student's regular transcript.

### Are you eligible?

Eligible students must meet the following criteria:

- Meet the entrance requirements of postsecondary education.
- Be in grade 10, 11, or 12.
- Have a minimum cumulative 2.5 on a 4.0 scale GPA
- Maintain continuous eligibility.

### Courses we offer:

- Academic or Career Technical Courses in a Traditional or Distance Education format\*

\*Meet with your high school counselor to select the best option for you. Placement scores are required for English, math, and science courses.

### Benefits of DE/DC Program:

#### Cost Savings

- Tuition and fees at NW-SCC are significantly less than those at four-year universities
- Distance Education courses are offered at a discounted rate for DE/DC students
- Students taking an on-campus class may apply for a \$100 scholarship per semester

#### Simultaneous Credit

Earn academic/technical credit for both high school graduation and a college degree.

#### To Apply:

1. Complete an application for admission and student I.D. Policy form.
2. Submit your transcript, including ACT, SAT, or ACCUPLACER scores.
3. Complete and submit a DE/DC Agreement form.
