*6 In order to complete English courses in a distance format, students must have Microsoft Word or ability to save documents in Microsoft Word format.

*7 In order to complete CIS146, CIS147, or CIS148 in a completely distance format, students must have Office 2013/365. Windows 7 is required for CIS249.

*10 Students are encouraged to come to campus three times during the semester to deliver speeches. Students who are unable to come to campus must have a camera/video recording device, microphone, high speed internet connection, and access to 10 audience members who are age 18+.
