New distance students should complete the distance education orientation in Moodle before the first day of class. All distance courses require at least one proctored or on-campus exam. \*4 – In order to complete online English courses, students must have access to Microsoft Word or the ability to save documents in Microsoft Word format. Office 365 is available for free through student email.

\*6 – The labs for distance BIO103 & BIO104 will be conducted online. Students do not have to register for an on-campus lab.

\*8 – Students are encouraged to come on-campus three times during the semester to deliver speeches. Students who are unable to come to campus must have a camera/video recording device and access to 10 audience members who are age 18+.
